Camp Keir Summer Camp Programs are much more than just fun for the youth. Camp is often a child's first extended trip away from home. An effective camp experience enables the child to become a self-sufficient individual. Living together in a rustic setting, campers share unique adventures and have many opportunities to grow on the inside, by being outside.



OUR PURPOSE

is to develop Christian faith and character in an atmosphere of fun and recreation. We offer a caring, sharing environment that gives each camper an opportunity to develop physically, emotionally and spiritually through living together in an outdoor setting.

OUR SITE

is located in the beautiful community of Canoe Cove, PEI., bordering on the Northumberland Strait. Our centre offers comfortable accommodations for our campers, with four to six campers per room, dining hall, chapel in one building, art/craft area in a second building. The site features a sports field, multi-sport court, beautiful sandy beach and natural surroundings to explore. Camp Keir is located on Route 19 beside Canoe Cove Presbyterian Church.

activities include daily Bible study, archery, arts and crafts, campfire, sports and games. As well, several other special events are held during camp, such as talent shows, outdoor cooking, Survival Day, field trips, swimming and drama. One of our most popular events for teens is the overnight canoe trip. Imagine guiding your canoe down a scenic river while our experienced staff teach you the fundamentals of canoeing and camping, as well as lead you in worship and praise, Bible and devotions. Space is limited for this, so register early!

OUR LEADERS

are carefully selected, some are former Camp Keir Campers. Each year, a training program is held to acquaint leaders with program and aims. We want you to rest easy knowing that your child will have fun and that they are in good, qualified hands.

CAMP FEES:

Everything is included in our fees a four-day camp is \$165 per child and the six-day camp is \$220. **You will receive a \$25 discount on your registration fee if you register by June 1st 2012. If you bring a new camper to camp you will receive an additional \$25 off your camp fee. Add the new camper name on your Reg. form.**



If you are unable to meet the cost of the full camp fee, a Scholarship Fund is available to help cover part of the cost. You may request assistance from our Scholarship Fund.

The parent/guardian certifies that the applicant participant is normal in condition, habits and is amenable to necessary discipline. Failure to disclose problems at time of application could result in dismissal.
