

Camp Keir FAQ

Is there a projector at the camp?

Yes, we have a large screen and projector which you may use by connecting to it with your own computer. The screen is at the front of the room. To open it, there is a little button on each side of the screen about halfway up. Push them in and pull the screen open horizontally to the size you need. Please close it when you are done with it.

Do you have sound equipment?

No, unfortunately we do not have sound equipment available for rental groups. It is suggested you bring a set of speakers which plugs into your laptop for sound. If you have a band playing, they will have to bring their own sound gear.

Is there internet at the camp?

No, unfortunately we do not provide internet access to our rental groups.

What do we do with our garbage?

As outlined in the rental form, you are required to remove all garbage from the camp unless other arrangements have been made. We charge \$50 for garbage removal (the cost of Superior Sanitation removal, or our camp custodian to dispose of it). Please discuss with Amy if you wish to have someone remove your garbage after your event.

What do we do with the dirty dishtowels we used?

Cleaning and laundry supplies are all provided at the camp. We ask that you clean each room (including bathrooms and the kitchen) so they're as clean as when you arrived. We ask that you launder dish cloths and towels before leaving. There is a laundry room downstairs with all required supplies.

What's the second building on the camp site?

This is called the "craft building." It is not winterized and is used mostly for storage in the winter. Please talk to Amy if you wish to use this building.

What if we need a First Aid kit?

There is a First Aid Kit on the wall in the hall by the kitchen for your use in case of minor accidents.

Can we use the church at the end of the lane for a special service?

The church is Canoe Cove Presbyterian Church which is not directly connected to the camp. You would have to make special arrangements with the church about its usage. Otherwise there is the meeting hall in the camp as well as an outdoor chapel by the steps leading down to the beach.
